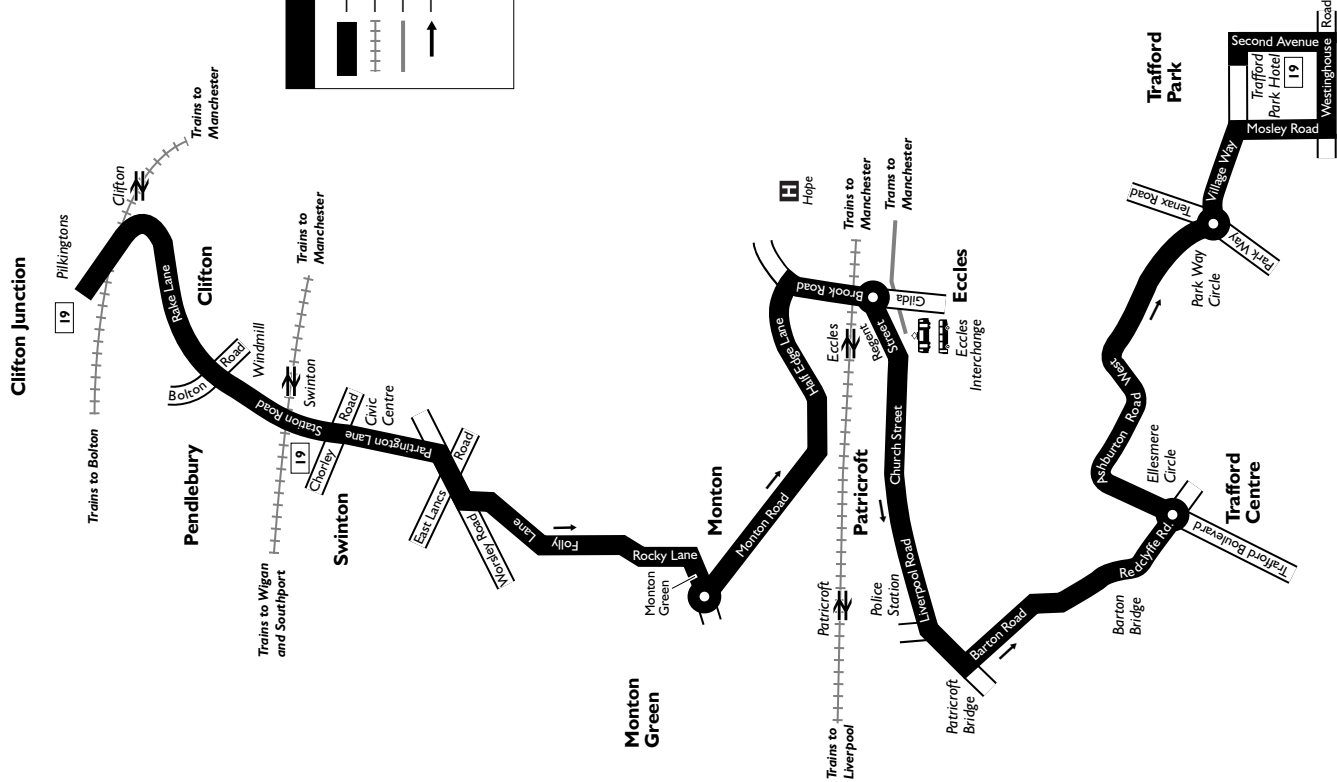
The first two are the hour and the last two are the minutes. Use this converter to find the am and pm times:
