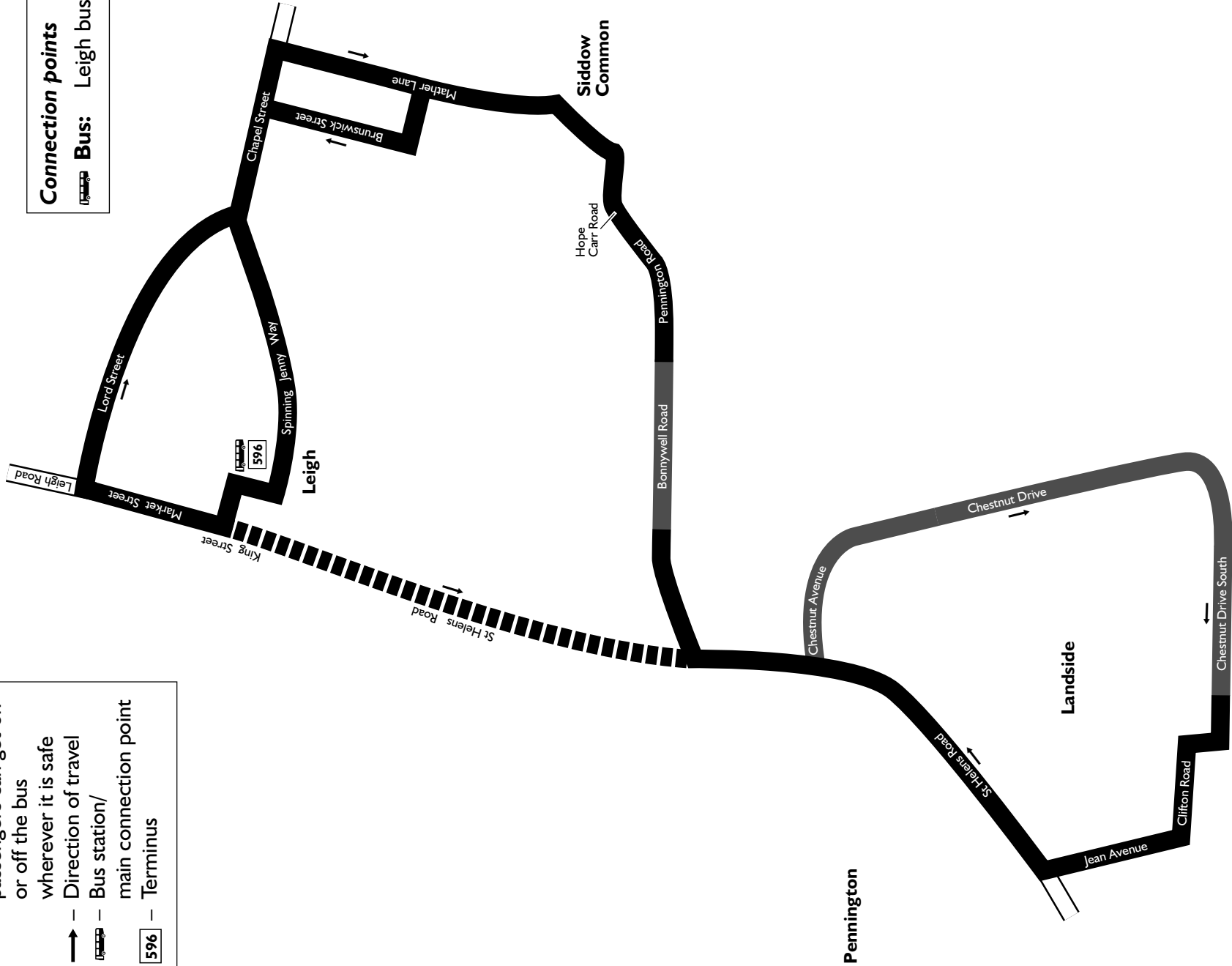
Route plan for bus number
