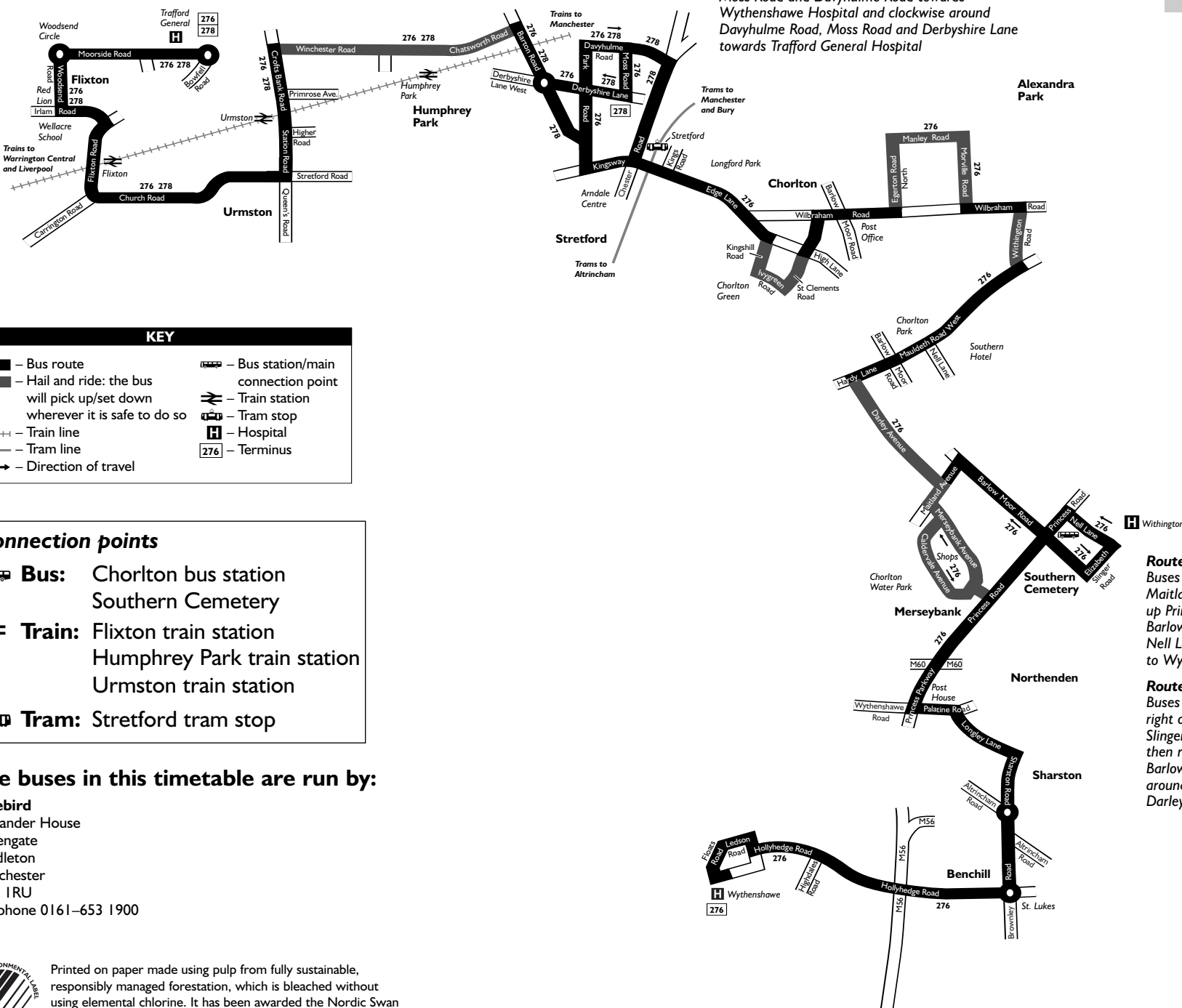
Using the 24 hour clock

Times are shown as a four figure number. The first two are the hour and the last two are the minutes. Use this converter to find the am and pm times:

24 hour	12 hour	24 hour	12 hour
0100 ...	1 am	1300 ...	1 pm
0200 ...	2 am	1400 ...	2 pm
0400 ...	4 am	1600 ...	4 pm
0500 ...	5 am	1700 ...	5 pm
0600 ...	6 am	1800 ...	6 pm
0800 ...	8 am	2000 ...	8 pm

Examples: 0813 is 13 minutes past 8 am
1737 is 37 minutes past 5 pm.

Bus 276 runs anti-clockwise around Derbyshire Lane, Moss Road and Davyhulme Road towards Wythenshawe Hospital and clockwise around Davyhulme Road, Moss Road and Derbyshire Lane towards Trafford General Hospital

Route from Trafford General Hospital
Buses run along Darley Avenue then via Maitland Avenue, Caldervale Avenue, up Princess Road then right onto Barlow Moor Road, Elizabeth Slinger Road, Nell Lane then straight down Princess Road to Wythenshawe Hospital.

Route from Wythenshawe Hospital
Buses run straight up Princess Road then right onto Barlow Moor Road, Elizabeth Slinger Road, Nell Lane, Princess Road then right at Southern Cemetery onto Barlow Moor Road, Maitland Road, loops around Merseybank then back onto Darley Avenue.




