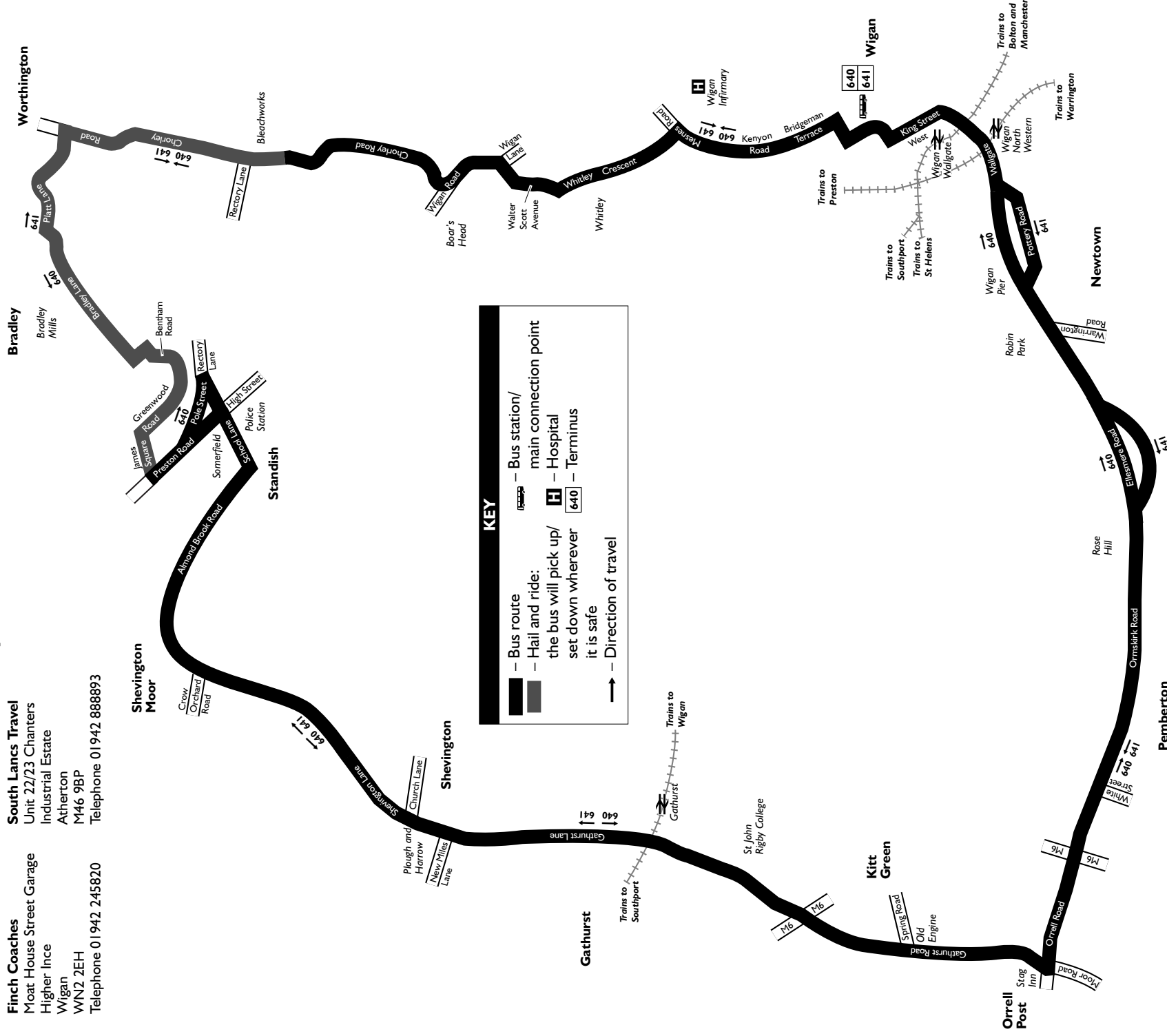
Route plan for bus numbers
