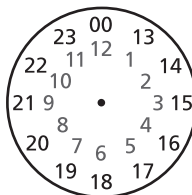

minutes.








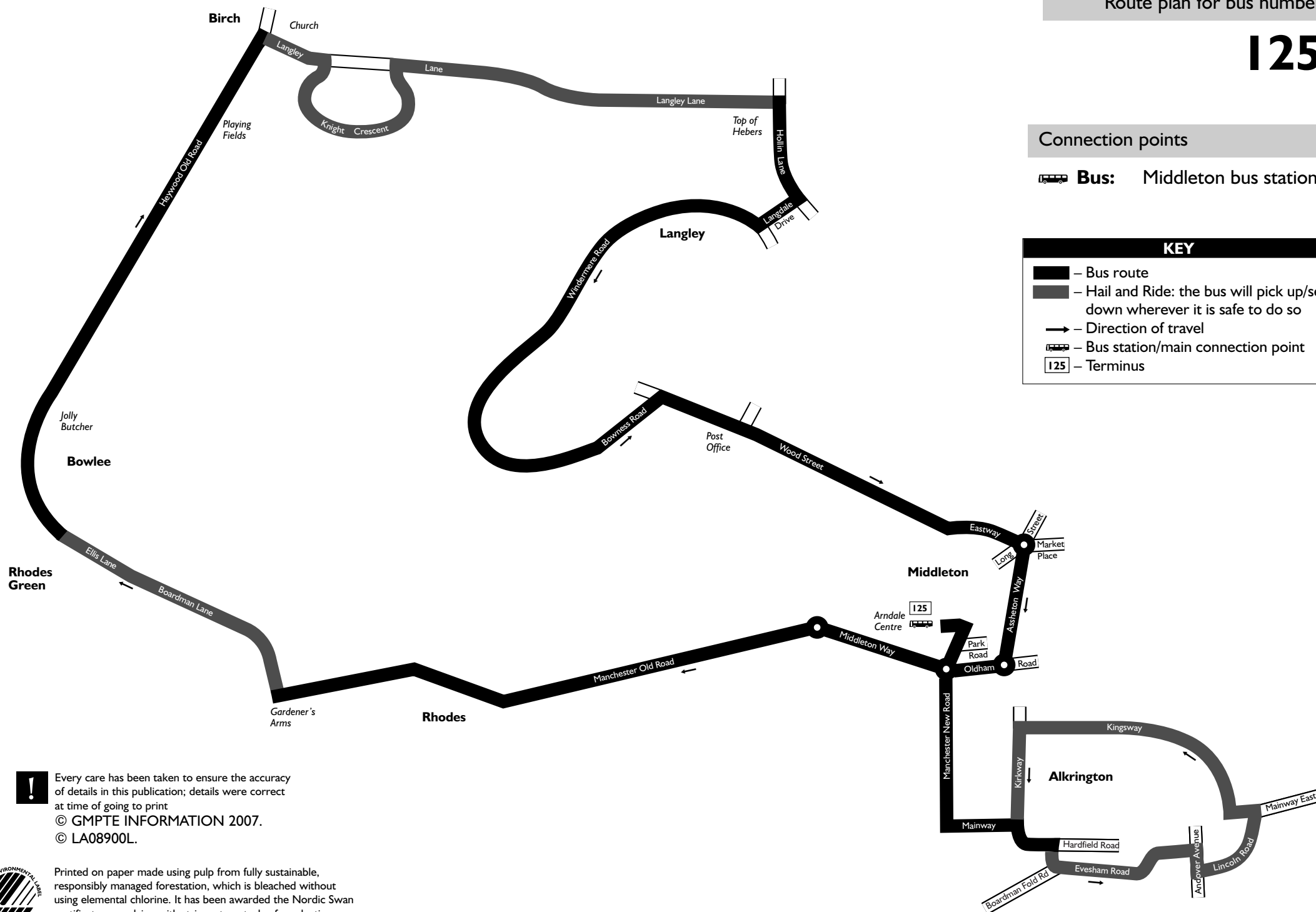
Examples: 0921 is 21 minutes past 9 am
