Main stops on the route are listed on the left. Each journey reads down the page.

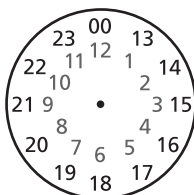
Where no time is shown against a particular stop, the bus does not stop there on that journey.

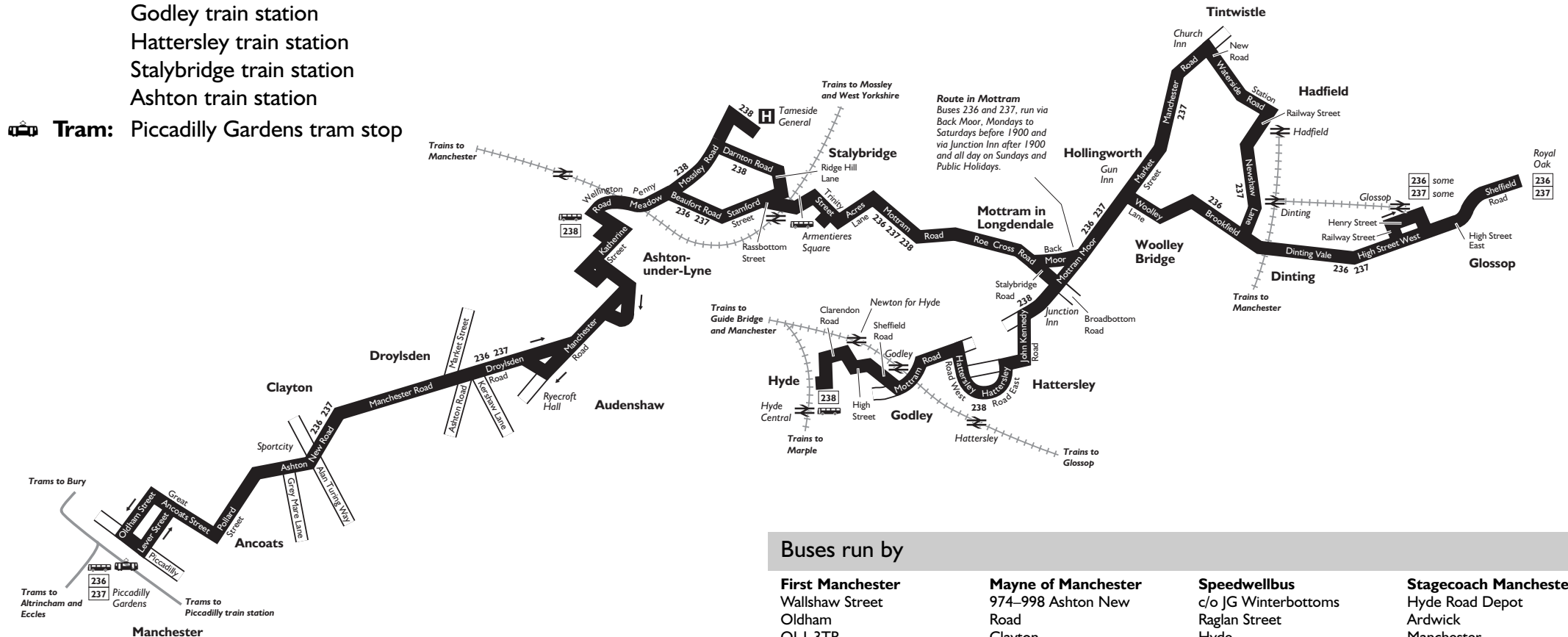
