Journeys displaying this symbol in the timetable are run with **low floor** buses which have no steps at the entrance, making getting on and off easier. Where shown, **low floor** buses have a ramp for access and a dedicated space for wheelchairs and pushchairs inside the bus.

The bus operator will always try to provide easy access services where these services are scheduled to run. In case of difficulty, please contact the bus operator.

Timetables show the direction of travel, bus numbers and the days of the week.

Main stops on the route are listed on the left. Each journey reads down the page.

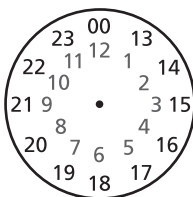
Where no time is shown against a particular stop, the bus does not stop there on that journey.

Using the 24 hour clock

Times are shown in four figures. The first two are the hour and the last two are the minutes.



Examples:

0921 is 21 minutes past 9am

2148 is 48 minutes past 9pm

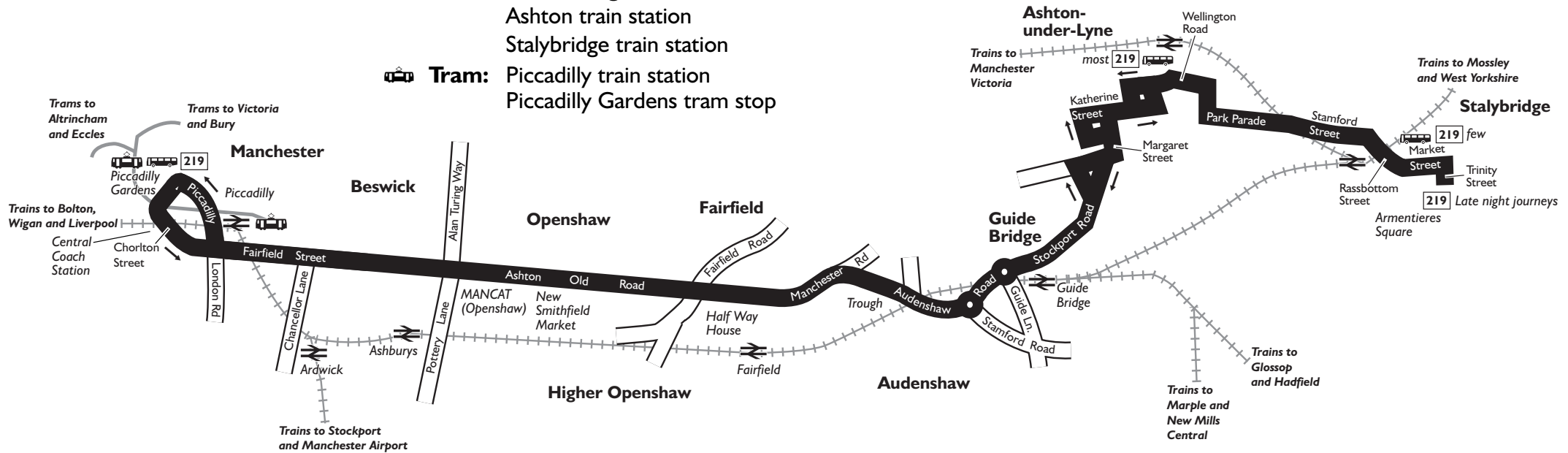
