Where shown, low floor buses have a ramp for access and a dedicated space for wheelchairs and pushchairs inside the bus. The bus operator will always try to provide easy access services where these services are scheduled to run.

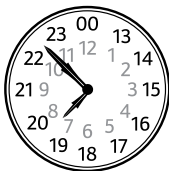

The map illustrates the bus route 610, which connects Wigan to Warrington and back. The route is shown as a thick black line with arrows indicating the direction of travel. Key locations and roads along the route include:

- Wigan:** The route starts at King Street West, near Durning Street and Wallgate. It passes the North Western train station and the Wallgate bus station.
- Newtown:** The route continues through Pottery Road, Saddle Junction, and Ormskirk Road, passing Aldi and Robin Park.
- Worsley Mesnes:** The route turns onto Worsley Mesnes Drive, passing Poolstock Lane and Carr Lane.
- Hawkey Hall:** The route passes Fulbeck Avenue and Colby Road, near the Shopping Precinct.
- Warrington:** The route continues along Warrington Road, passing Marus Bridge and the M6 motorway.
- Bryn:** The route turns onto Bryn Road, passing the Bryn train station and the South Lancashire Industrial Estate.
- Wigan:** The route returns to Wigan via Lockett Road and Bryn Road.

The map also shows various train lines and stations, including Trains to Preston, Trains to Southport and Kirkby, Trains to Manchester, Trains to Warrington and St Helens, and Trains to Wigan and Preston. The route is marked with a '610' terminus symbol at Wigan.
