Journeys run with low floor buses have no steps at the entrance, making getting on and off easier. Where shown, low floor buses have a ramp for access and a dedicated space for wheelchairs and pushchairs inside the bus. The bus operator will always try to provide easy access services where these services are scheduled to run.

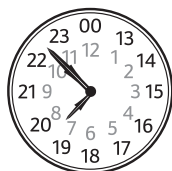

This map illustrates the bus route 42, which runs from Cheetham Hill in the north to East Didsbury in the south. The route is marked with a thick black line, and the direction of travel is indicated by arrows. Key locations along the route include Cheetham Hill, Cheetham, Manchester, Rusholme, Fallowfield, Withington, and Didsbury. The map also shows various landmarks, including hospitals (North Manchester General Hospital, Manchester Royal Eye Hospital, St Mary's, Royal Manchester Children's Hospital), universities (University of Manchester, Manchester Metropolitan University), and parks (Owens Park, Whitworth Park).
