Times are changed. Buses are also rerouted to run direct via Manchester Road instead of Swinton Park. The route is also changed in Pendleton, Ordsall and Salford Quays with buses running via Fitzwarren Street, Langworthy Road, South Langworthy Road and Broadway instead of Churchill Way, Liverpool Street and Oldfield Road. Buses will also run via Ordsall Lane. Some Monday to Friday peak period journeys are extended to Clifton. Bus 73 will replace bus 79 for journeys along Overdale.

Journeys run with low floor buses have no steps at the entrance, making getting on and off easier. Where shown, low floor buses have a ramp for access and a dedicated space for wheelchairs and pushchairs inside the bus. The bus operator will always try to provide easy access services where these services are scheduled to run.

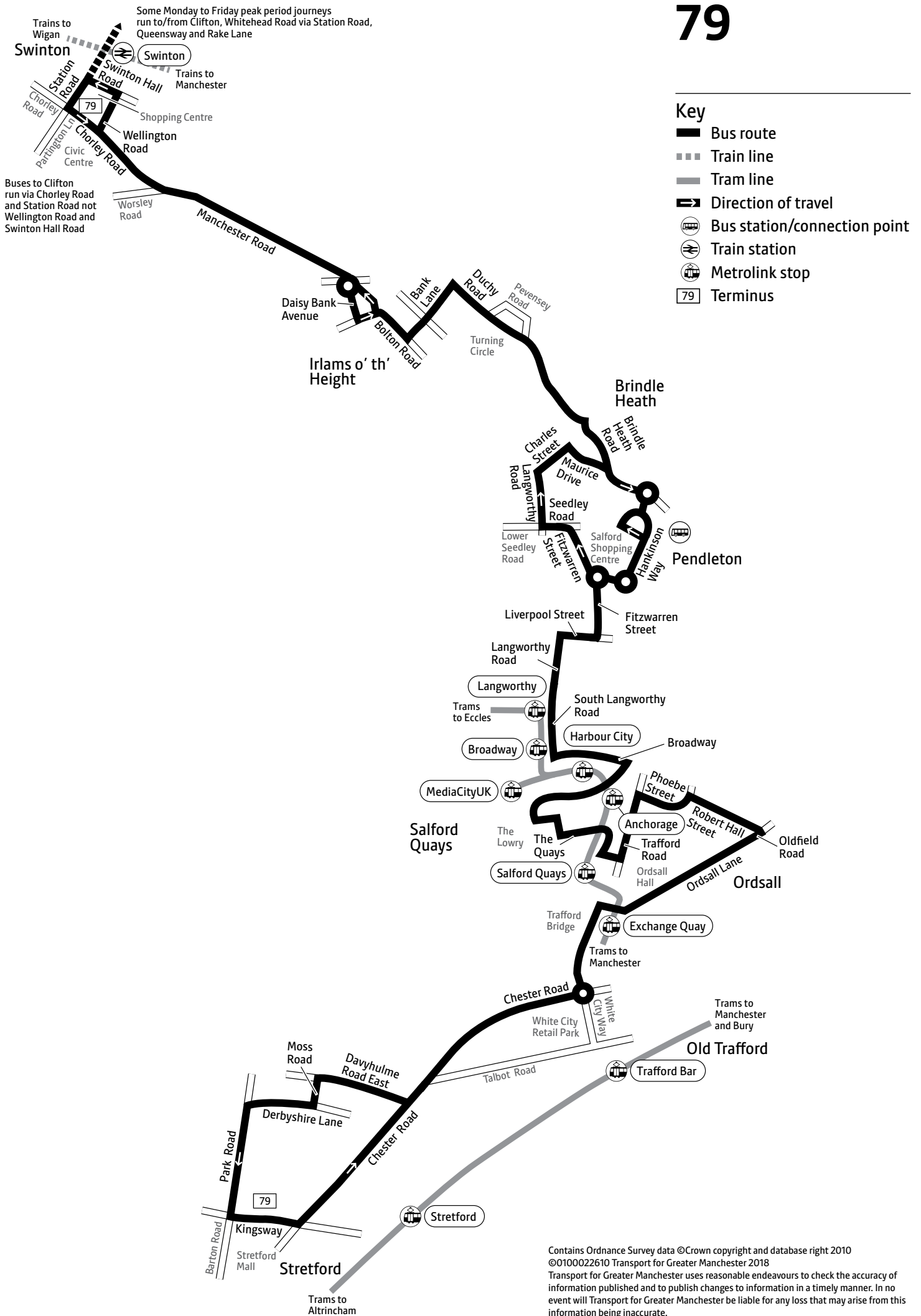
