Journeys run with low floor buses have no steps at the entrance, making getting on and off easier. Where shown, low floor buses have a ramp for access and a dedicated space for wheelchairs and pushchairs inside the bus. The bus operator will always try to provide easy access services where these services are scheduled to run.

Main stops on the route are listed on the left. Where no time is shown against a particular stop, the bus does not stop there on that journey. Check any letters which are shown in the timetable against the key at the bottom of the page.

From Lower Place, the route continues south through Kirkholt and Balderstone Road, eventually returning to Rochdale via Hill Top Drive and The Strand. The map includes various landmarks such as Rochdale Railway Station, Rochdale Metrolink stop, and Rochdale Interchange. It also shows the locations of trains to Littleborough, Todmorden, and Halifax, and trains to Manchester. 
