The bus operator will always try to provide easy access services where these services are scheduled to run.

Other roads shown on the map include Sainsbury's, Heaton Park Road, Munn Road, Glenbrook Road, Victoria Avenue, White Moss Road, Rochdale Road, Newcliffe Road, Greengate, Gardeners Arms, Lightbowne Road, Nutthurst Road, and Moston Lane.
