Welcome to your new bus timetable

We (Merseytravel) have produced this new bus timetable as your bus service has recently changed. We **do not** run bus services - they are run by private bus companies. However, we pay towards essential bus services which the bus companies do not run. In timetables, these services are called Merseytravel Bus **Services** and are shown by the symbol $\mathbf{\Phi}$.



How to use this timetable

The timetable is split into routes and days of the week (see 1 below). Please make sure you are looking at the timetable for the right direction you want to travel in. The travel direction is shown across the top of the page.

On the left side of the page there is a list of the main bus stops for the service (see 2 below).

To the left of these stops is a list of numbered boxes (see 3 below) which will help you find the bus stop on the route map (the map is shown on a separate page within the booklet). There is also a description in writing of the route the bus takes.

The time the bus leaves each stop is shown in a column running down the right-hand side of the page (see 4 below). Each column of times is a separate bus journey. Read the column from top to bottom.

First, look for the bus stop nearest where you want to get the bus from. Then, look at the times shown on the same line to find the time nearest when you want to get the bus. Read down the list of times until you get to the time opposite a place near to where you want to get off the bus. The time is your arrival time.

We can't show times for every bus stop, or the timetable would be too big to print in a booklet. Please remember to look for any codes at the top of the page or alongside each column which may change your journey (see <u>5</u> below). You can find an explanation of these codes in the 'Codes' box at the bottom of the timetable. You can find all the bus-stop codes we use in this booklet at the bottom of this page.

In some timetable booklets, we show some of the bus stops in italics (see 6 below). This means we have given a rough time for that stop because the bus company has not given us an exact time.

Route 156 (Arriva Monday to Saturday daytime): from ST HELENS BUS STATION via Corporation Street, Parr Street, Atlas Street, Pocket Nook Street, Park Road, Blackbrook Road, West End Road, Clipsley Lane, Wagon Lane, Ledger Road, Wedge Avenue, Old Whint Road, West End Road, Vicarage Road, Stanley Bank Way, Liverpool Road, Tithebarn Road, Garswood Road, School Lane, Victoria Road, Downall Green Road, Rectory Road, Leyland Green Road, Garswood Road, Station Road, School Lane, Garswood Road, Tithebarn Road, Liverpool Road, Stanley Bank Way, Vicarage Road, Clipsley Lane, Wagon Lane, Ledger Road, Wedge Avenue, Old Whint Road, West End Road, Blackbrook Road, Park Road, Pocket Nook Street, Atlas Street, Parr Street, Corporation Street, Hall Street, Bickerstaffe Street, Hardshaw Street, Corporation Street to ST HELENS BUS STATION.

Schoolday only journey operates as above 0745 journey to Wigan Road then via Gerard Street and Warrington Road to ST EDMUND ARROWSMITH/BYRCHALL HIGH SCHOOL.

Route 156 (0758 journey from Booth's Brow Road and evening and Sunday Merseytravel journeys): from ST HELENS BUS STATION via Corporation Street, Parr Street, Park Road, Blackbrook Road, West End Road, Vicarage Road, Stanley Bank Road, Liverpool Road, Tithebarn Road, Garswood Road, School Lane, Garswood Merseyrail station, Station Road, Garswood Road, Billinge Road, Rectory Road, Booths Brow Road, Downall Green Road, Wigan Road to ASHTON-IN-MAKERFIELD LIBRARY.

Return via the reverse of the above route to Corporation Street then via Hall Street, Bickerstaffe Street, Victoria Square, Corporation Street to ST HELENS BUS STATION.

Route 256: from GARSWOOD MERSEYRAIL STATION via Strange Road, Station Road, Garswood Road, Billinge Road, Birch Grove, Leyland Green Road, Rectory Road, Downall Green Road, Victoria Road, Strange Road, Camp Road, Low Bank Road, Old Road, Bryn Street, Gerard Street, Wigan Road, Old Road, Low Bank Road, Camp Road, Strange Road to GARSWOOD MERSEYRAIL STATION.
